

Reading and Writing

- Individual Reading and Writing classes (adapted Teachers College Workshop Curriculum-we focus on skill building by using our Next Generation Standards)
- Explicit instruction in opinion, argument, information, and narrative writing with in class independent writing time
- Explicit instruction in reading skills and strategies while including in class independent reading
- Each reading and writing classroom has a dedicated library filled with a variety of genres, trade books, and supplementary materials

Social Studies

- Encourages student voice and promotes agency through accountable talk, Socratic seminars, fishbowl conversations, and democratic mock trials
